### **Quotes & invoicing**

We do not wish to use the artist regulation ('artiestenregeling') under Article 5a of the Salary Tax Act (Wet LB) and Article 4 of the Decree of 24 December 1986 (social security) for our performances, which means that no employment relationship is created. We explicitly choose not to have payroll taxes paid and not to be insured for employee insurance ('opting out'). This complies with Article 3bis of the Salary Tax Act (UR LB) and Article 4, paragraph 2 of the Decree of 24 December 1986. This choice allows you to pay us the gross fee for the performance.

For performances for non-private clients in the Netherlands, we charge 9% VAT. We state this amount separately on our quote and invoice.

For performances outside the Netherlands but within the EU, we apply a VAT deferral. If you agree, we ask you to provide us with your Chamber of Commerce number.

Quotes and invoices for private clients always include 9% VAT. This applies to clients both within the Netherlands and outside the EU.

Payment must be made within 14 days of invoice date.

### **Cancellation**

If you cancel the agreement 48 hours or less before the performance, we reserve the right to charge 100% of the fee (excluding travel expenses) to compensate for preparations already made and time reserved, unless the reason for cancellation is our fault. If the agreement is canceled between 2 weeks and 48 hours before the performance, this amount is 50% of the fee (excluding travel expenses). After consultation, a different agreement can be made in the client's favor.

If we are unable to perform a confirmed gig due to force majeure (such as illness, an emergency, or unforeseen circumstances), we will consult with you to find replacement musicians. Any additional or reduced costs will be discussed with you in advance. If we are unable to find a replacement, the gig will be cancelled. Any costs we have already incurred for the gig will not be charged.

### **Outdoor performances**

Our instruments are not moisture-resistant. If we have to perform outdoors and the weather conditions are poor, you are required to provide a roof and shelter from the wind.

### **Rider**

The sound equipment provided must meet the requirements in the technical rider provided by us.

### **CD sales**

We reserve the right to sell CDs before, during, or after our performance.

### **Liability**

You are liable for all damage to us and/or our property caused by yourself, your employees and/or the public. You indemnify us against any third-party claims relating to any damage we cause during the event; you will be responsible for compensating this damage yourself.
